

Consent to AI-assisted documentation

A short note about the tool your clinician uses to write up your visit.

Before we begin, we want you to know how we document our conversation. Your clinician uses **Eluve**, an ambient AI assistant that listens during the visit and drafts an accurate clinical note from what's discussed. It lets us give you our full attention instead of typing throughout.

We only use Eluve with your agreement, and your information is handled with care and in line with Eluve's Privacy Policy. Its main purpose is to support the documentation of your visit.



What Eluve does

Eluve helps write up your consultation, capturing only what's needed for an accurate medical record.

It supports your clinician; it doesn't replace them. Every clinical decision is made by your clinician alone, who reviews and approves each note.



Your information

- Your information is processed and stored in accordance with PIPEDA and applicable provincial privacy laws.
- Your data is never sold and never used for advertising.
- Your visit is recorded so Eluve can create an accurate note; the recording and resulting note are stored securely and handled only as described in Eluve's Privacy Policy.
- Everything is encrypted in transit and at rest, with access limited to your care team and regular independent audits.
- How your information is handled, stored, and used to help improve care is governed by Eluve's Privacy Policy, Terms of Service, and the Business Associate Agreement between your clinic and Eluve, all available at eluve.com.
